NOTICE of RACE

The regatta will be governed by the "Rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012

• **Eligibility and Entry**

Open to all Trailer Yachts

Any boat modification to be declared on entry

Entry fee of \$35 to be paid on day

• **Divisions**

1. Trailer Yacht open division, with spinnaker, without spinnaker
(There may be some alteration to the above divisions dependant on entries)

Five or more boats of a class will constitute a division

Times for the open divisions will be adjusted by NZTYA handicaps

2. 6.7 Joker Class and 820 Joker Class

• **Schedule of Events**

Registration: 9.00 to 9.45 hours Briefing: 10.00 hours (Saturday)

Racing: eight races are scheduled. One drop at race 5, 2 drops at race 8.

Sailing instructions will be available at registration

Courses sailed: Trapezoid, or W/L or triangle W/L (notified at briefing)

Scoring: Low points scoring system.

Prize presentation: at the completion of racing on Sunday

• **Venue: Lake Ngaroto**

Heading north from Te Awamutu on State Highway 3 (approx 2kms) turn left into Ngaroto Road, right into Paterangi Road and right into Bank Road.

• **Hospitality**

An area for camping on site, a large grassed reserve for your tent, camper van or sleep in your yacht (or Clubhouse).
